Fact sheet: Jean-Luc Marion (born 1946)

Jean-Luc Marion is a French philosopher and theologian. He is also one of the "immortals" of the Académie Française and professor emeritus at the University of Sorbonne in Paris and the University of Chicago.

A former student of Jacques Derrida, Marion is considered to be one of Europe's greatest contemporary thinkers. He has published numerous books, several of them well-known works of philosophy. Jean-Luc Marion has won several awards, including Italy's *Premio Joseph Ratzinger from Fondazione Vaticana Joseph Ratzinger – Benedetto XVI* (2021) and Germany's Karl Jaspers Award (2008).

Marion continues to work and recently published the book *Revelation Comes From Elsewhere* (2024), which is considered by many to be his masterpiece. The French daily newspaper Le Monde wrote this about the book earlier this year: "In the world of contemporary philosophy, Jean-Luc Marion stands out as one of the major heirs of the great religious thought of the West. A culmination of this role can be found in the properly theological approach that presides over his new book."
