## FORORD

Denne lille suite er satt sammen av fire norske folkeviser som alle handler om fugler. Den første - VISE OM FUGLER I SIN ALMINNELIGHET - er en opprampsingsvise, hvor tekstrfatteren forsøker å få med seg flest mulig fugler. Denne versjonen er nedtegnet etter Henrik Brændryen av O. M. Sandvik:

Kråka ho satt på åkre hemta kønn,  
hakkspetten satt og hakka,  
hakka på stubban' harde som hønn  
høyrd ei røy som lokka.

Lerka ho satt og spela så vilt,  
svala ho flaug og svinga så stilt.  
Lita furulus, sporv og hampetjuv,  
høyrd trasten kor han skratta.

De to siste finnes i Lindemans "Norske Fjældmelodier",  
den andre i Edvard Bræins "Folkemusikk fra Nordmøre".

### GÅSELEIKEN

Denne leiken fremføres gjerne som en vekselsang, og går som en slags "Bro, bro brille", hvor det er om å gjøre å få gåsa opp i gryta. Dansen jeg har brukt går i halling-takt, og skiller seg klart ut fra andre varianter. For en som i alle år har ferdet Mortensgås, til minne om den hellige Martin av Tours, er denne dansen blitt en naturlig del av ballasten.

### KATTUGLEVISA

En ensom vandrer treffer på en ugle, og han spur hvorfor den hyler så ynklig der den sitter. "Skal ikke jeg hyle", sier ugle, "jeg som sitter på låven og passer bondens korn, slik at ikke den grå musa eter det opp. Likevel får jeg bare kjeft. Mens katten - som er mitt søskenbarn - for samme jobben får melk i et fat og en varm seng borti ovnskroken. Skal jeg da ikke hyle?"

### DEN STORE KRÅKA

Å mann han gikk ut i tømmerskau,  
hei hu hei hu hallala,  
så så han ei kråke som gol på en haug  
og den kråka hu ville jo bite meg.

Å mann han gikk hen te kjerringa si,  
å kjære mi kjerring du redda mitt liv.  
Hu hei, hu ha, kossen gikk det så,  
hu hei, hu ha, kossen gikk det så?

"Den store kråka" kjenner vi fra mange versjoner. Den handler om mannen som skulle i veaskogen, men så kommer han løpende hjem til kjerringa si: "Det er ei kråke der ute som vil drepa meg," sier mannen. "Tøys", sier kjerringa, "ingen kråke vil drepe en kristen mann". Så blir mannen jaget ut i skogen igjen. Han skyter kråka, og resten av visa handler om hvordan han nyttiggjør seg alle fuglens deler. Den lykkelige utgang er at mannen ved endt arbeide får seg "så mang en bra manns rus".


