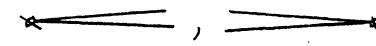

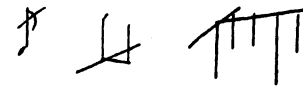

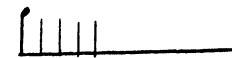
- Crescendo, decrescendo from niente/ to niente



- Grace notes should be played as fast as possible and always before beat



- Ordinary fermata
- Long fermata

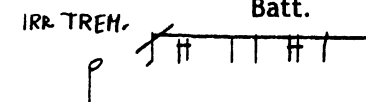


- Repeat the first note

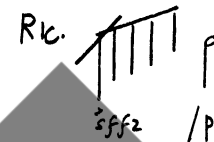

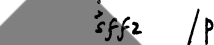

- Battutto



- Irregular tremollo between notes on same string



- Ricochet. Let the bow very rapidly bounce over all strings before reaching the written pitch. Place fingers on all string, damping them. The ricochet should be heard as a percussive effect not as a broken chord.



- Tremollo with light fingerpressure on the pitch marked with a cross



- Play on bridge with pitch



- Play on bridge without pitch



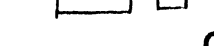
- Move bow rapidly between bridge and nut on the open strings.



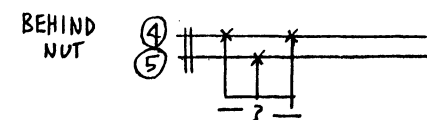
- Fast tapping on string on the indicated pitch.



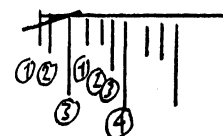
- Play on strings behind the nut



- Tap on damped strings. no pitches should be heard
