

## PREFACE Written by the composer

"The Three Mouseketeers" is inspired by and dedicated to my family's three pet mice named Lefty, Midly and Righty. They all got their names due the location of a black spot on their face. Lefty got the black spot on the left side of his face, etc.

These three short songs are all the same in their construction; they all consist of two bars introduction, bar 3 to 10 repeats (A and B theme), bar 11 the A theme comes back but with a plot twist in the last bar.

Interpretation wise the singers can feel free to make themselves sound like a small, cute and squeaky sounding mouse.

Some word play has been used in the text. Here is an explanation of those words:

- *Micey* is used both "Lefty's Song" and "Right's Song" (f.ex in bar 3). This is simply just a cute way my family refers to the mouse.
- *Mousetro* is used in "Midly's Song"(fex in bar 3), this is referring to the word "maestro" but with the word "mouse" included.
- Gabi's Mouseketeers (bar 10) in "Midly's Song" first of all refers to my stepdaughter who's full name we often shorten to a cute version, this cute version is Gabi. The "Mouseketeers" comes from the word "musketeer" but with the word "mouse" included.







