

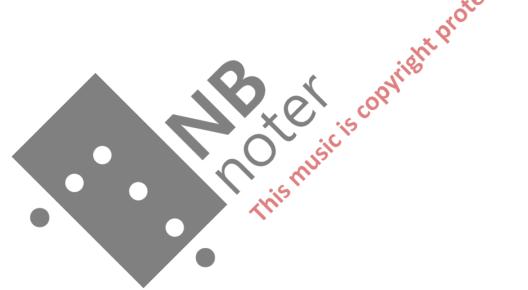



String orchestra  
minimum 16 strings: 54322




Approximately 5 minutes

# NOTATION

---

s.t.	-	sul tasto
s.p.	-	pul ponticello
batt	-	battuto
c.l.b.	-	col legno battuto (no hair, only the wooden part of the bow)
ord.	-	ordinary stroke (not s.p. or s.t.)
◊	-	bartok pizzicato



Play c.l.b. as fast as possible on muted strings - produce different "pitches" with the bow placement

s.t. → s.p. A transition from sul tasto to sul ponticello, to be performed as evenly as possible.

## GLISSANDI

Glissandi are always to be performed as evenly as possible.



Notes in parenthesis are guides (often turning points), not to be dwelled at.  
Stems are only to show the length of the glissando.

Bass harmonics are also transposed.
