


PERFORMANCE INSTRUCTIONS

EQUIPMENT


In addition to a grand piano with a sostenuto pedal (the middle pedal), a MIDI-keyboard with two octaves and octave buttons is needed for the piece as well as one elbow.

MIDI - KEYBOARD

The keyboard is programmed in Ableton Live and the notation is in two modes:



Notated like this the keyboard simply acts like a trigger. The recording that is triggered lasts for as long as the box indicates.



Notated like this the keyboard is playable, meaning that in addition to being touch sensitive (and able to perform dynamics) the samples also follow the performer's execution of duration. The top staff, called "tape", indicates what should be heard. Pay extra attention when the sample is longer than the duration in the score.

The keyboard starts with setting 1 where C1 on the keyboard should be set to CC (english system), meaning the octave should be set as low as possible. For every new setting the performer changes the octave setting of the keyboard two octaves up. (This means Setting 1 = -4, Setting 2 = -2, Setting 3 = 0 and Setting 4 = 2).


TEMPI

In parts with extensive use of samples, the tempo is 60 in order to make the notation of samples easier to work with. Elsewhere, the performer is encouraged to experiment with tempi in order to make the material breathe.


ACCIDENTALS

In parts with bars, accidentals lasts for the length of the bar. Elsewhere in the piece, accidentals only apply to the specific note.

PEDALS



When the sostenuto pedal (the middle pedal) is used, it is notated with a line



When the use of the damper pedal is notated it is critical to play as notated, but the pedal can be employed by the performer in other instances as well.



Diamonds indicate an open string and must be pressed down silently. Here, the sostenuto pedal holds the c# until the next group of tones.


The thick black line between the two diamonds means a cluster (chromatic). Smaller clusters, like this one, can be achieved with one hand, larger might need both arms.

Slam open hand on side (body) of instrument to make a percussive sound.



Right fermata is of shorter duration, left fermata is long and usually with a given time in seconds.



Abruptly press down and release the right pedal (to make a reverberation noise)



Pluck string with fingernail.



▽ Pluck string with plectrum.
