




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

### **Preparation:**



#### **Violin I**

In the beginning of the piece the violin is prepared with a knitting needle between IV and II string. The knitting needle is made of metal with measurements 3 mm in diameter, and 20 cm long. The III string is situated on the middle of the needle, and the needle is placed just above the fingerboard to get the right pitches (see score). E string is prepared/damped with a piece of bubble plastic underneath the string.



#### **Violin I**

Also needs a 30 cm long thin wooden barbecue stick, placed between IV and II string. See score.



#### **Violin II**

Needs a knitting needle of metal with measurements 3 mm in diameter, and 20 cm long. The needle is to be placed between IV and II string. The III string is situated on the middle of the needle, and the needle is placed just above the fingerboard to get the right pitches. See score.



### Violin II

Also needs a wooden ice cream stick to be prepared between I and III string.  
The II string is situated on the middle of the stick.  
See score

### Viola

#### **Scordatura:**

the C string is tuned down to H (B natural)  
The score is in two versions, one fingered and one sounding.



The viola player needs a 30 cm long thin wooden barbecue stick, placed between IV and II string. The III string is situated on the middle of the stick. See score.



### Cello

The G-string is prepared with a round plastic coated paper clip + tack it, that is placed on quarter-tone low D.  
Makes (around) high C sound.

The cellist also needs a plastic chop stick.

#### **4 Different boxes**

Each musician needs a small box, filled with some pearls and a hex bug.  
The boxes must be of different sizes and material, it can be a of metal, wood, paper and glass.  
The sound is supposed to be in the background, sounding like a tropical rainforest ambience.
