Bars 8-14, 70-75, 114-119, 182-188, 289-294 represent the "simandron" calling on Easter Day, the most important celebration in the Greek Orthodox Church.

B (bars: 36-50), and D (bars: 88-97) are original Greek folk-songs, in my arrangement.

All else is mine but closely inspired by and respectful of Greek music traditions.

Although the piece uses several different percussion instruments, care has been taken to only need two percussionists at the same time.

The performers when changing instruments, may if needed use some extra time.
